PROS

Forklifts powered by LPG (*Liquefied Petroleum Gas*) have long been popular due to their competitive pricing and their extreme versatility. They come equipped with either cushion or pneumatic tires allowing them to work well on a variety of ground surfaces.

Because LPG engines are usually derivatives of car engines, parts are often readily available at affordable prices.
